Sub: Extension of approval of affiliation to Sardar Patel Subharti Institute of Law, Swami Vivekanand Subharti University, Meerut, Uttar Pradesh for imparting five year BA LLB law course with an intake of two sections of 60 students in each section.

Sir,

Legal Education Committee at its meeting held on 18<sup>th</sup> October, 2015 considered the above mentioned subject. After consideration, Committee made the following recommendations: -

The Legal Education Committee considered the inspection report submitted by the inspection team. After consideration the Committee is of the view that **Sardar Patel Subharti Institute of Law, Swami Vivekanand Subharti University, Meerut, Uttar Pradesh** be granted extension of approval of affiliation for running **five year B.A. LL.B.** course with an intake of **two sections** of 60 students for a period of **three years** i.e. academic year 2015-2016, 2016-2017 and 2017-2018 subject to the following conditions:

1. The college must appoint a regular permanent qualified principal for the college.
2. The Law College must provide the Legal Aid Clinic as per Clause—11, Schedule—III of Rule—11 of the part IV of the Legal Education Rules-2008. It must be at the entrance of the institute.
3. The Moot court room should modify as per norms of the BCI.
4. The number of Law-Books as well as non-Law books is not sufficient. The College must purchase more books during the academic year. The Law College should purchase law books well as non-law books for the said course worth of Rs. Fifty thousand every year and provide Wi-Fi facility to the students.
5. The Law College should ensure the payment of salary to teachers as per Rules 22 schedule III, Part IV of BCI Rules.
6. Teacher Student ratio shall be 1 : 40.

Further, the college should follow the attendance rule and file reply that they are going to follow the aforesaid rule. The next inspection team must see whether the said rule is being followed by the university or not. The relevant Rule 12 is given below :-

**"12. End Semester Test: No student of any of the degree program shall be allowed to take the end semester test in a subject if the student concerned has not attended minimum of 70% of the classes**

*Provided that if a student for any exceptional reasons fail to attend 70% of the classes held in any subject, the Dean of the University or the Principal of the Centre of Legal Education, as the case may be, may allow the student to take the test if the student concerned attended at least 65% of the classes held in the subject concerned and attended 70% of classes in all the subjects taken together. The similar power shall rest with the Vice Chancellor or Director of a National Law University, or his authorized representative in the absence of the Dean of Law.*

*Provided further that a list of such students allowed to take the test with reasons recorded be forwarded to the Bar Council of India."*

Institution should submit affidavit in compliance to the above conditions within six weeks.

College authorities are also required to apply to the Bar Council of India for further extension of approval six months in advance before expiry of the period of approval of affiliation granted by the Bar Council of India i.e. on or before 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2017 in respect of five year BA LLB law course.

The above recommendations were considered by the Bar Council of India at its meeting held on 18<sup>th</sup> October, 2015 and accepted the same.

This is for your information and necessary action.

Sir,

The inspection report of the above University was placed before the Legal Education Committee at its meeting held on 26<sup>th</sup> June 2009 and Committee made the following recommendations :-

"Legal Education Committee considered the inspection report of Swami Vivekanand Subharti University, Meerut, UP submitted by the inspection team of the Bar Council of India. After consideration Committee is of the view that Swami Vivekanand Subhasrti University, Meerut may be recognized as per Section 7 (1) (i) of the Advocates Act 1961 for conferring degree in B. A. LLB Course for a period of two years i.e. for the academic session 2009-2010 and 2010-2011. Committee also recommend for shifting of existing law students of Subharti Institute of Law, Meerut (affiliated to C. C. S. University, Meerut) to Subharti Institute of Law, Meerut now affiliated to Swami Vivekanand Subhasrti University, Meerut subject to issuance of "No objection Certificate" for transfer of affiliation by the C.C.S. University, Meerut. The University has to comply with the following conditions:-

- Discussed with V.C. 22/7/09
1. To pay salary to the teaching faculty members as per Clause 22 in Schedule III, Rule 11 in Part IV of the new rules of the BCI.
  2. To spend Rs.1,00,000/- for the library only for purchase of books, law journals, Indian Bar Review, etc.
  3. The management, Board of Governors, must follow the instruction given by the UGC and other Govt. Authorities.
  4. Teacher - student ratio should be as per Schedule III Rule 11, Clause 17 Part IV of the new rules of the Bar Council of India.

Further, Committee makes it clear that as per the new rules of the Bar Council of India relating to Legal Education, maximum intake in one section should be 60 students from the academic year 2009-2010 and therefore.

The above recommendations were considered by the Bar Council of India at its meeting held on 27<sup>th</sup> June 2009 and accepted the same.

The college shall also comply with the following Rules of the Bar Council of India (Clause (iii) and Explanation 2 of Schedule IV in Part IV new rules of the Bar Council of India) :-


"Whenever approval of affiliation is granted to the Centres of Legal Education, it shall be necessary for the Centres of Legal Education to deposit Rupees Two Lakh in shape of guarantee to fulfill all the norms of the Bar Council of India. The same shall be liable to be forfeited if norms are not complied with and same shall carry no interest."

The approval of affiliation now granted by the Bar Council of India is subject to the payment of guarantee amount as mentioned in the above rule.

The amount may be remitted by way of crossed Demand Draft drawn in favour of the "Legal Education Fund A/c of the Bar Council of India" on any Nationalized Bank payable at Delhi.

University authorities are also required to apply to the Bar Council of India for further extension of approval of affiliation six months in advance before expiry of the period of approval of affiliation granted by the Bar Council of India.
